



Key responsibilities

- To lead and take responsibility for the technical aspects of King's College performing arts activities and spaces.
- To offer production and technical support to King's College Drama Productions and to fulfill their artistic vision and potential.
- To use the technical resources of King's College to support the artistic aspiration and development of the students.
- To enhance and maintain the technical facilities of King's College as a major resource in line with our aspiration to be one of the leading drama departments in the private sector.
- To manage the overall maintenance, upkeep and security of all technical equipment and performance spaces.

To improve the technical resources of King's College to maintain a technical specification appropriate for contemporary theatre practice.

To provide and create the sound, lighting and set designs and provisions for the school productions and academic productions.

- To provide technical support for commercial hires and visiting companies as appropriate.
- To provide production management support to King's College. This includes, but is not limited to, managing technical production budgets, scheduling activities, coordinating builds and hires, and managing all health and safety aspects within the theatre.
- To work with the Head of Drama to support all activity in the department.
- Supervise all technical work undertaken by pupils as part of the curricular or extra-curricular school performing arts programme.
