It has been a busy (and much more comfortable) second week of the term in which the hobbies programme commenced, Y7 Pelican Pals were recruited to begin their duties next week and the children reflected on the importance of having our Golden Rules. Our assembly friend, Lion Law, came along to assembly on Monday to help us develop our understanding of how the laws of our land and the rules of our school help us to keep safe, happy and healthy. I was impressed with the children's knowledge of road safety (wearing seatbelts, speed limits and the lines on the road that tell you when you can/can't overtake/park) as well as of who helps to enforce those laws and rules (Father Christmas being one of the first names suggested!) We read a story to help us consider what our school might be like if we abolished the rules and realised that while it might initially sound like a fabulous idea, it would soon become a place full of grouchy, upset and sad people. We have learned a song to try to help us 'stick to the rules like glue' and will explore each of our six Golden Rules in more detail over the coming weeks.

Thank you to the parents who attended the EYFS presentation on Monday. I hope you found it informative, and you went away with a little more knowledge about this stage in children's learning than you had when you arrived. TT Club

A polite reminder to book your child into TT Club, including children in Nursery. Forest School Clothes

It is important for the children to wear long sleeves and long trousers/leggings to Forest School to keep them protected from nettles, brambles and holly leaves as well as from bites, stings, or ticks. This forms part of our Risk Assessment and so, going forward, if a child does not have the correct clothes, we may not be able to take them to the woods. This also applies to any child who arrives wearing a skirt or dress as these items of clothing are not appropriate for the type of activities we plan and do.

Hopefully, you have received a letter about the Vision Screening team visiting us in the next few weeks, as part of the National Screening Programme. It is important you complete this letter to opt-out if you do not wish for your child to take part.
